Parking:

- All vehicles in parked within Crosswinds **must have a valid parking pass** during the towing hours 12:00AM to 6:00AM.
- Commercial Vehicles are not to be stored on the property, and may be towed during the towing hours. This includes work trucks, taxis, limos or buses.

Following are some of the items that were discussed at a recent Board meeting:

- Sidewalk repair: Management is soliciting bids for repairs to sidewalks throughout the community.
- Roof and Firewall Inspection: Inspection was completed late January. Planning for repairs/replacement is underway.
- Hand Rails: The Board is reviewing proposals to replace and add new handrails on the property.
- Mailbox Replacement: The Board has reviewed and selected a mailbox style and is reviewing proposals for installation.
